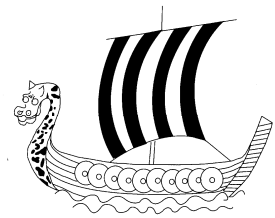

Late Arrivals

There have been several incidents recently when children arriving late have been taken straight to class rather than to the office. This has resulted in them being marked absent in the register. It is vital that children are recorded in the registers in case of an emergency. Please help us keep your children safe by bringing them through the school office if they arrive after the bell has gone. Thank you.

End of the Day Procedures

At the end of the day in KS1 your child's teacher will not allow your child to leave the classroom until they can see the person they are expecting to collect them. In KS2 the procedure is slightly different as we encourage the children to be more independent. At 3.15pm the children will be allowed to leave the classroom on the strict understanding that if the person they think is going to meet them is not where they expect them to be they return **immediately** to the school office. The office staff will then contact the child's parents. If your child has an after-school activity but forgets they should also return to the office as there will be no-one waiting in the usual place to collect them.
